## A Note from the Pastor...



Dear Members of MZSL, in our February newsletter, we let you all know that we will resume our Congregation Vitality Process that we had been working on before the pandemic hit and changed all our plans. We, like Christian churches all over the

globe, have been wondering how we might best serve God and our neighbor in these challenging times. Now, more than ever, we need to come together as a people of God to finish our discernment process as to who we are, why we are here, and what God would have us do to meet the needs of our neighbors in Oglethorpe. Lent is the perfect time for searching our hearts and asking for God's direction as to what ministry opportunities we should engage in.

The best way to learn the needs of the people who live in the shadow of our steeple is to ask them! This is the schedule we have planned to lead us in our Lenten process of discernment:

**Sunday, March 6<sup>th</sup>**: After worship and lunch, Pastor Barb will lead us in a short devotion. She will then give a brief run-down of the prayers we listed in our previous small group prayer meetings before the pandemic hit. We will then break out into Small Groups only long enough for each of us to choose a name or two apiece from a list of businesspersons, city officials, agencies or neighbors to contact in the next two weeks. We will ask them three simple questions aimed at identifying the needs in our community.

**Sunday, March 13<sup>th</sup>** After Soup, Our Small Groups will meet to share learnings from our first week of contacts, writing down our findings. It may take a while for everyone to reach the person or agency they have chosen, so we will continue to reach out until Sunday, March 13<sup>th</sup>. *Pastor Barb will meet with Confirmation Class*.

**Sunday, March 20th,** After Soup, we will continue our small groups to finish sharing our listenings from our neighbors with the group. By the end of this small group meeting, each group will have a list of needs and possible ministry opportunities for MZSL to consider.

**Sunday, March 27**<sup>th</sup> .After Soup, we will gather as a large group and compare lists, combine any similar ideas and organize needs into possible ministry opportunities. We will all take the list home and pray on it.

**Sunday, April 3<sup>rd</sup>,** After Soup, we will gather as a large group and choose one or two ministries we want to engage in as a congregation to begin in 2022. We will work out a timeline, who will lead it, funding, etc.

In order for this to work, we need each of us to be invested in the ministry we choose to support. We need the input of every member, so please make every effort to participate in this vital work of our church. Thank you in advance for your prayers as to how MZSL can best be of service and represent Christ as a part of Oglethorpe and our surrounding communities.

Last month, I included some of the Cinquain poems that our Confirmation Youth had written as part of their studies. A Cinquain poem uses the following pattern:

Confirmation

- 1 word as your Subject
- 2 words describing the subject
- 3 words describing the subject's activity
- 4 words describing your feelings about it
- 1 word with the same meaning as the subject.

The assignment was to read the Apostles Creed, pick a word that spoke to them and create the poem from that word as his or her Subject. This exercise helps us think about what we believe and deepens our understanding of the Apostles Creed as a way of expressing our faith. Here is another of our student's poems:

Pyromania


